

## Vigneron's Selection Shiraz 2024



Vine age: 20 years

Density: 2645 vines per hectare Yield: 10.0 tons per hectare

The only Shiraz vineyard on GlenWood finally achieved the desired balance to produce premium quality grapes. Well balanced growth delivers even ripeness and beautiful structure.

Vinification:

The best quality grapes were selected, gently crushed and fermented in half-ton open-top fermenters. The grapes were punched down by hand 3 times a day and fermented until dry. The wine underwent malolactic fermentation in barrel and was matured for 12 months in 2<sup>nd</sup> fill French oak to produce a well-integrated,

complex profile.

Analysis:

Alcohol 13.5% Total Acidity 5.6 g/l Residual Sugar 2.2 g/l pH 3.66

Winemaker's Comments:

Deep ruby in colour. Dark berry and chocolate on the rich nose. Juicy and jammy on the grippy and full palate with cassis, compote and blackberry on the aftertaste. A layered and complex wine. Drink through 2035.
