Viticulture:	Vine age: 20 years Density: 2645 vines per hectare Yield: 10.0 tons per hectare The only Shiraz vineyard on GlenWood finally achieved the desired balance to produce premium quality grapes. Well balanced growth delivers even ripeness and beautiful structure.								
Vinification:	The best quality grapes were selected, gently crushed and fermented in half-ton open-top fermenters. The grapes were punched down by hand 3 times a day and fermented until dry. The wine underwent malolactic fermentation in barrel and was matured for 12 months in 2 nd fill French oak to produce a well-integrated, complex profile.
